Thomas Hartmann: Cities On View in Boca Raton, Fla.

BOCA RATON, Fla.— *Cities*, an exhibition of paintings by German artist Thomas Hartmann, will be on view in Rosenbaum Contemporary's Boca Raton, Fla., gallery (150 Yamato Road) from Sept. 12 through Oct. 31. The exhibition, which is open to the public, can be viewed during regular gallery hours, Tuesday through Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Inspired by picture postcards, Hartmann began painting cities in the 1980s. The works in the exhibition illustrate the bird's-eye view perspective that Hartmann is known for as well as his ability to capture single moments in bustling urban centers. His work has been shown throughout Europe and the United States in numerous venues including the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum in New York, the Toledo Museum of Art in Ohio and the National Library in Warsaw, Poland.

Rosenbaum Contemporary, founded in 1979, is based in Boca Raton, Fla., with a second gallery in Palm Beach, Fla. The gallery caters to international collectors interested in investment-quality works by postwar, modern and contemporary masters and presents nationally recognized museum-level exhibitions throughout the year. The gallery also offers a wide range of free services to collectors worldwide including acquisition advice, art consulting, sourcing of artists, art collection building and management and resale of select works of art.
